

Cherry Papers (D2166)

Summary

c.1000 legal, political and family papers and documents, 1882-1938, comprising the records of eminent Irish academic, lawyer, and politician Richard Robert Cherry, 1859-1923.

Cherry served as Attorney General for Ireland between 1905 and 1909, as a member of the Liberal Government and was then appointed to judicial office as a Lord Justice of Appeal. He held this post for five years until February 1914 when he became Lord Chief Justice of Ireland, a position he held until December 1916.
