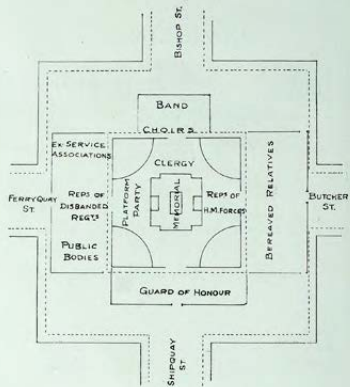

Thursday, 23rd June, 1927.

12 noon.

The Guard of Honour, provided by the British Legion, and Band of the 1st Battalion, The Sherwood Foresters, will be in position in The Diamond, as indicated on plan.

Representatives of His Majesty's Forces identified with the City of Londonderry, and invited guests, will take up positions, as indicated on plan.

A Programme of Music will be rendered by the Band.

12.15 p.m.

Major-General Ready, accompanied by the Mayor and Town Clerk, will leave the Guildhall and proceed to the War Memorial.

On arrival at the Diamond, Major-General Ready will inspect the Guard of Honour.

12.30 p.m.

The Band, and the Choir, under the conductorship of Mr J. T. Frankland, will lead the singing:

RECESSIONAL.

God of our fathers, known of old,
Lord of our far-flung battle-line,
Beneath whose awful hand we hold
Dominion over palm and pine—
Lord God of Hosts, be with us yet,
Lest we forget—lest we forget!

The tumult and the shouting dies,
The captains and the kings depart,
Still stands Thine ancient sacrifice,
An humble and a contrite heart.
Lord God of Hosts, be with us yet,
Lest we forget—lest we forget!

Far-called, our navies melt away,
On dune and headland sinks the fire;
Lo, all our pomp of yesterday
Is one with Nineveh and Tyre!
Judge of the Nations, spare us yet,

The Chairman will introduce the proceedings and call upon Major-General Ready to unveil the War Memorial.

Major-General Ready will deliver a short address, unveil and dedicate the War Memorial.

One Minute's Silence will be observed by the Assembly.

The commencement of the period of silence will be indicated by the sounding of drum roll.

The termination of the period of silence will be signalled by a further sounding of drum roll.

The Band will play the following Hymn, and the Choir will lead the singing:

The Band will play a Lament.

The Buglers of the 1st Battalion The Sherwood Foresters will sound "The Reveille."

The Chairman will then formally hand over the custody of the War Memorial to the Corporation, and the Mayor (Senator James Hamilton, J.P.) will respond.

The following Wreaths will be placed on the Memorial:

- (1) By the Mayor on behalf of the Citizens of Londonderry.
- (2) By Major-General Ready, on behalf of the Northern Ireland District.
- (3) By Councillor H. Crawford M'Cay, on behalf of the British Legion.
